Product installed – 31m of 2m high JCW Reflective Sound Screen

The enquiry was received by our team of expert fencing specialist on 19th October 2015. JCW challenged with proposing a suitable sound barrier to reduce airborne noise generated from a new hand car wash area, however the works had to be completed to a tight deadline (4th November).

JCW arranged to send a Surveyor to site for measurements and detail the type of dig for the timber posts. We immediately realised that due to the lack of ground area we had to work in that this was going to be a challenge but not impossible.

Once JCW had recommended our cost effective **Reflective Sound Screen** solution the installation work began. Two of our experienced acoustic fencing erectors travelled from Bolton to Bordon in order to complete the works within the agreed timescale. The erectors travelled on a Sunday night to ensure they could begin the work at 8.00am on Monday 2nd November.
